LEAD HEALTH INTERVENTION PROGRAM

As part of the Coeur d'Alene Basin Project, the Panhandle Health District is conducting public health intervention programs to inform site residents of the potential for exposure to lead and how to reduce the risk there of.

INTERVENTION ACTIVITIES INCLUDE:

- A yearly blood lead screening for children 6 months through 6 years of age
- Follow up of children with a blood lead level of 10 μg/dl or greater
- Education and counseling on managing exposure pathways
- Prenatal blood lead screening and counseling on how to reduce exposure
- K-3 education for students in local elementary schools, Head Start and the Christian Academy
