TLG CONFERENCE CALL SUMMARY June 8, 2006

Agenda Items: ICP Map

Anne Dailey led the call as the Chair, Brian Spears, was unavailable. She informed everyone that Michael Bogert had recently resigned as the Regional Administrator of EPA, Region 10 to take a position as Counselor to the U.S. Secretary of the Interior, Dirk Kempthorne. Dailey mentioned that Bogert's resignation is not effective until July 8; and that Ron Kreizenbeck (EPA) would resume his former position as Acting Regional Administrator until a replacement is appointed.

Round Table:

Harwood: Indicated that he was taking a poll of TLG members who were interested in a 5-page copy of the ICP map because it was too large of a file to download as one document. Harwood reported that he visited with Commissioner Rick Currie in regards to the ICP section and that Kootenai Country prefers a two-tiered approach. In regards to funding for the county TLG representatives, he reported that a copy of the funding agreement had been sent to the county commissioners for their review.

Harwood also mentioned that he met with TerraGraphics about putting together maps for the infrastructure inventory in order to focus on various needs such as the dike system, stormwater drainage, dredging, and groundtruthing.

Dailey: Nothing to report.

Zilka: Said that he is working on the proposal for yard remediation work to begin on July 1.

Brewer: Nothing to report.

George: Nothing to report.

Stevens: Nothing to report.

Hardy: Nothing to report.

Masarik: Nothing to report.

Sheppard: Mentioned that the river inflow is down now and that the Post Falls dam is starting to shut the gates to keep the water flow at summer level.

Beckwith: Nothing to report.

Stromberg: Reported that 51 properties have been completed and 56 are in process. He indicated that the current contract ends June 30 and will be replaced with new contracts.
