Round Table:

Dailey: Mentioned that construction was moving along on the conservation easement.

Adams: Said that he had received a copy of the draft hydrological report on water treatment for Canyon Creek which contained a comparative analysis on the different options for treatment. He mentioned that the report would be sent to the PFT and would also be available on the web. Adams then gave a brief update on mine/mill work. For the Rex, he indicated that the work was almost done and the site would be hydro-seeded. He also informed everyone that a mine/mill PFT meeting would be set up in September to identify and coordinate work in developing an inventory of mine/mill sites. It would then be prioritized for human health concerns.

Masarik: Nothing to report.

Zilka: Indicated that the Denver Creek project would be starting in September. He also mentioned that the work on the Pine Creek project was progressing slowly and that the final report for the Canyon Creek project should be completed soon.

Brewer: Nothing to report.

DeLange: Nothing to report.
