TLG CONFERENCE CALL SUMMARY May 2, 2013

Agenda: None

Round Table:

Terry Harwood - Said that he sent a copy of the draft BEIPC meeting agenda to the TLG and asked if anyone had additional agenda items to suggest. Then he provided a brief overview of the work he has been coordinating in the Box for remedy protection projects. This includes engineering, contract administration, and getting signatures on documents. He noted that the City of Smelterville has signed the O & M agreements for the Grouse Creek project and it's heading to final design.

Then Harwood provided updates on: 1) EPA is funding the unpaved roads program from the Special Account (SA). There is a big savings as the cost originally was estimated at \$25 million, but will be approximately \$5 million; 2) EPA asked him to help with engineering on some of the Trust work and he is also helping to get signatures on the agreements; 3) The State has asked him to help with the remedy protection in the Box; and 4) EPA and the State are working on a way to transfer funding for the paved roads program to the Box and Basin.

Jeri DeLange - Indicated that she is working on the arrangements for the BEIPC meeting on May 22nd at the Wallace Inn.

Randy Connolly - Nothing to report.

Jamie Brunner - Mentioned that Becki Witherow (Limnologist) will be leaving IDEQ at the end of the month.

Sandra Raskell - Commented on the Superfund Job Training Initiative (JTI) program. She said that some good candidates participated in the training.
