- Flood Risk Assessment Modeling Report.
- Current FEMA Flood Maps are based on a 2002 Hydrologic Study. New Report using more current data indicates that there is a considerable difference in hydraulic loadings vs the one used to develop the current FEMA Flood Maps.
- Based on Report presented in February 2019 more work was needed; Alta Engineering compiled current work and developed a scope of work which was presented to FEMA.

Additional Work Needed

- Gather survey data on reach of river crosssections from Elizabeth Park to Pinehurst.
- Work funded by BEIPC and Kellogg City.
- Work performed by Alta Engineering and submitted to COE for use in finalizing modeling report.
- COE finalize report February 2020.
- Revise FEMA Flood Maps.

Flood Map Revision

- A letter of map revision LOMR for the modeled reach is needed.
- LOMR application is required to be submitted to FEMA.
- Objective of LOMR is to obtain a letter from FEMA officially revising the current flood map to show changes to flood plains, regulatory floodways or flood elevations per 44 CFR Parts 60,65 and 72.

Next Actions Needed

- Secure funding for LOMR request cost estimated for this work is \$35,000.
- Contract with consultant to prepare LOMR request.
- Submit request to FEMA for action.
- Pursue funding for Levy upgrade in vicinity of Bunker Ave Bridge – only true leveed and occupied reach in the study area where upgrade is needed from COE report.
