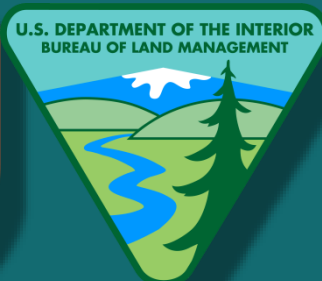

- 4) Bob Steed is representing DEQ on the Technical Staff



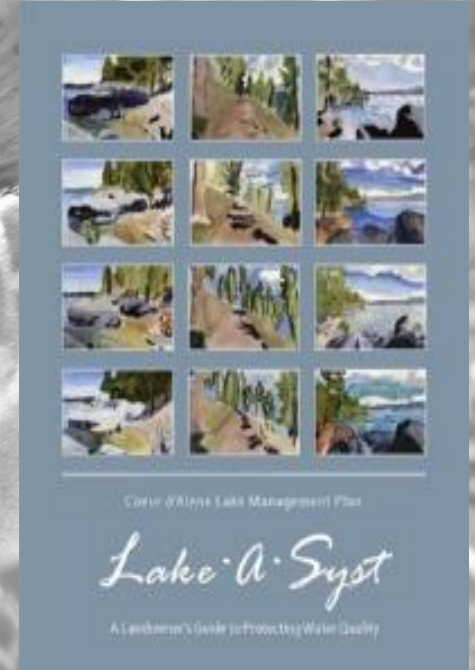

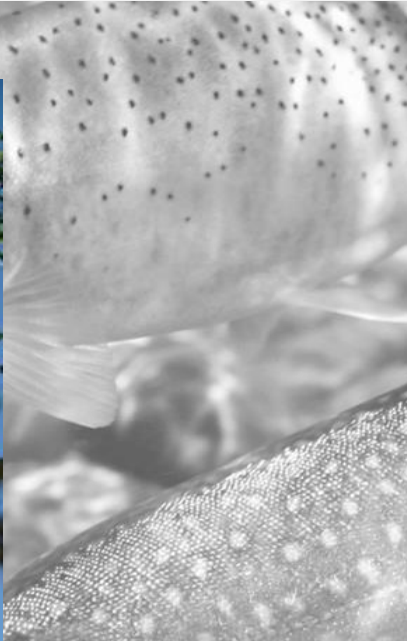

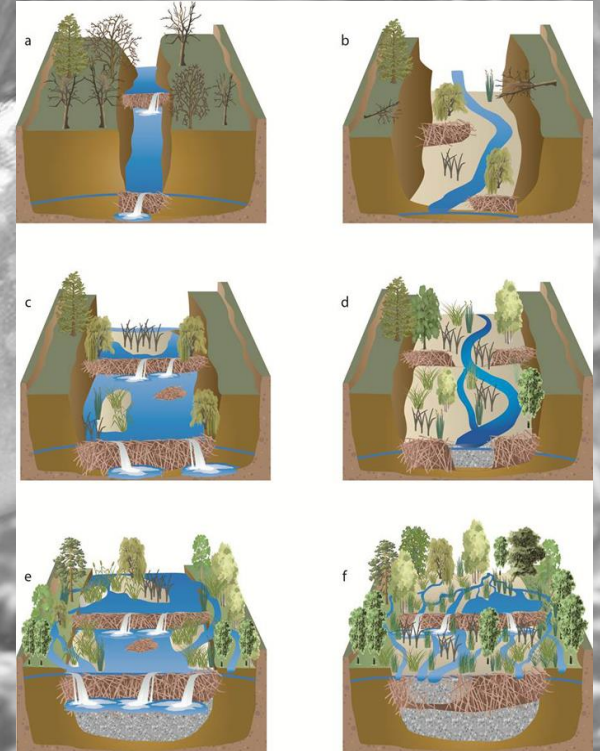
