



# Cataldo Boat Launch Cleanup



Coeur d'Alene Basin Cleanup

September 2021



On September 20, crews will start cleanup work at the Cataldo Boat Launch in Cataldo, Idaho. Crews will haul metals-contaminated soils from the boat launch to the East Mission Flats repository. Crews also will cap contaminated soil with gravel, soil and/or sod and replace damaged asphalt. The work will help protect people and wildlife from exposure to lead and arsenic. The Coeur d'Alene Work Trust will perform the work, directed by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. EPA expects this work will be completed in early October.

## Work Schedule

Work will take place from 7:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. EPA does not expect major traffic impacts; however, traffic control measures will be in place and some parking areas will be closed when work is taking place. During asphalt removal and replacement activities, the entire boat launch will be closed so the work can take place safely. Signs will be installed at the boat launch to notify the public of closure dates. Closure dates will be coordinated with the Idaho Department of Parks and Recreation, Shoshone County, and the Idaho Transportation Department.
