

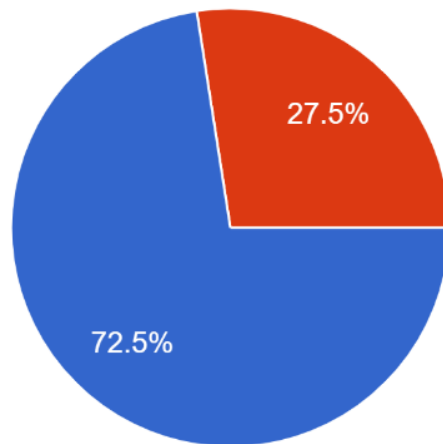

51 responses



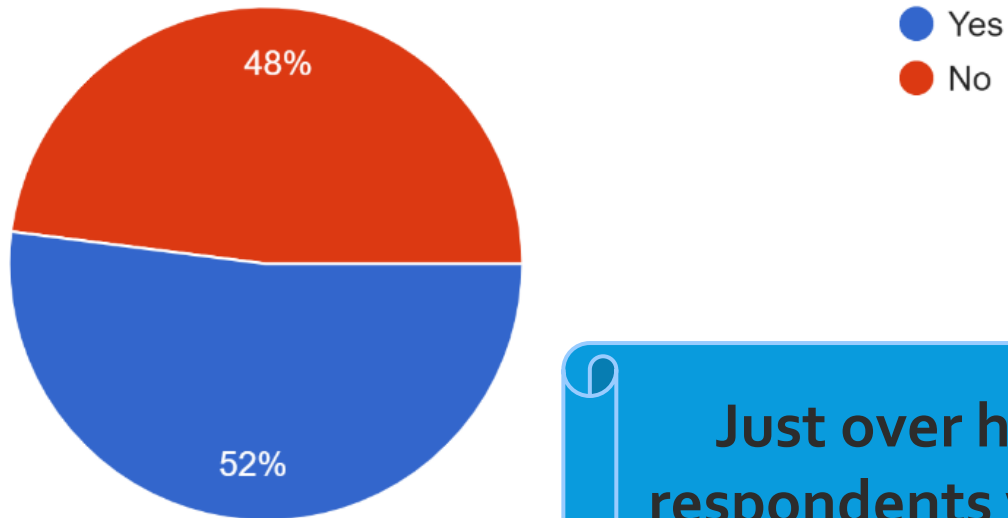

50 responses

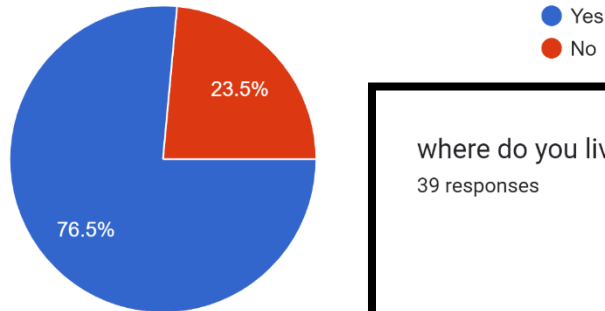


**Just over half of the respondents were aware of the BEIPC**

# CCC Survey Results

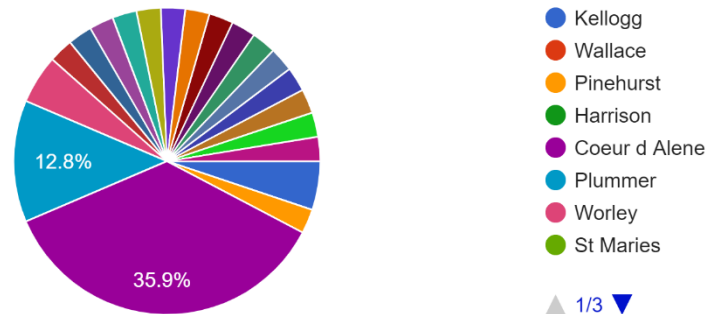
Do you live in the CDA Basin? The Coeur d'Alene Basin includes all the land that drains water into Coeur d'Alene Lake and out the Spokane River.

39 responses



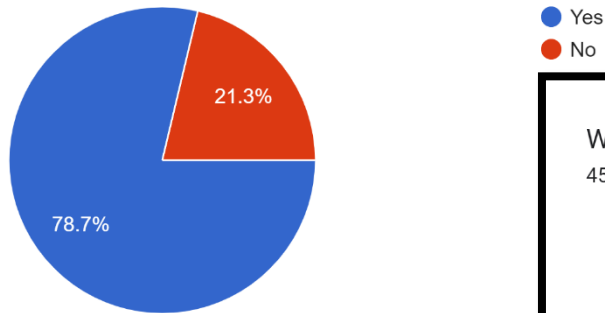
**Over  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the respondents live in the CDA Basin.**

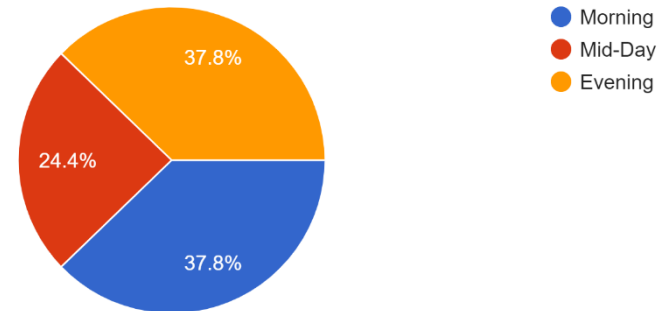
Would you be interested in attending a CCC meeting?

45 responses

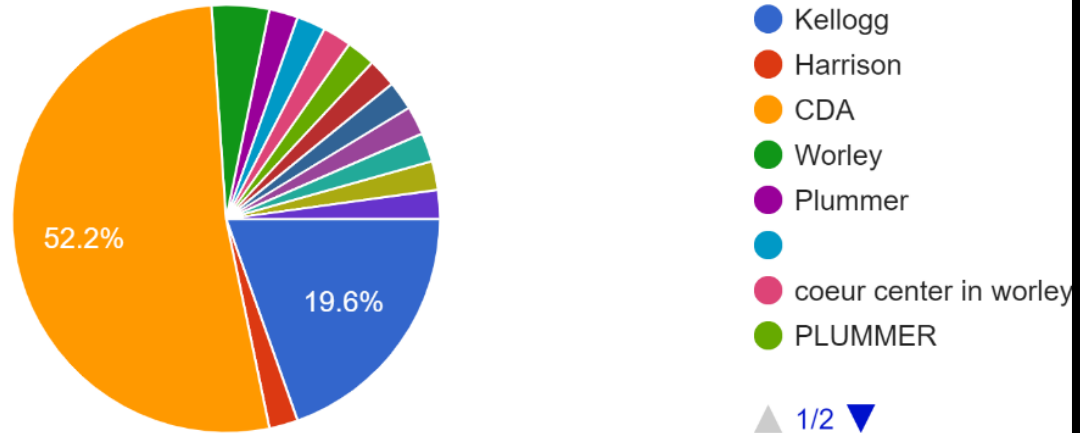


**Over  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the respondents would like to attend a CCC meeting**

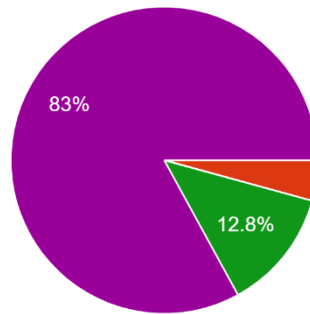


**Respondents would like the meeting to be held in Coeur d'Alene followed by Kellogg**
